We received a letter yesterday from the Department for Education to say that we are in Group 3 of the Rebuilding Programme for Schools and the proposed start date for this group is from April 2027. Although this start date is later than we would have anticipated, we are pleased that the rebuilding programme is still on track considering the current issues with RAAC concrete in schools. At present we have no further updates regarding this but when we get some information from central government, you will get an update.




Named Equipment

School Dinners

If you would like your child to change from packed lunch to school dinners (or vice versa) then the office requires one week's notice. Your support with this is appreciated. Just a reminder to parents who are paying dinner money on ParentPay to ensure the account stays in credit. Our lunches are provided by Chartwells through Durham County Council. Please note that all infant children (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) are entitled to a free school dinner through government funding. If your infant child is currently on packed lunch and you would like them to receive their free lunches, please telephone the school office to let us know.

Contact Details

It is very important that we have your up to date contact details including mobile phone number. If we need to contact you in case of emergency for example, it is vital that you are able to answer and respond quickly. If you have changed your number recently please telephone school so we can update our records. This also includes any phone numbers on your child's 'Collect ed By' form that lets us know who can collect your child. Please remember that only adults aged 18 or over can collect a child and therefore we will only accept numbers and details for them. We politely request that all children are collected on time after school and your help with this is appreciated.
